Updated: January 2006

TERM: 3 years for tenured and tenure-track faculty members, with possible re-election. The following terms are for one year, with possible re-election: students; full-time, non-tenure track instructional staff; and part-time faculty member.

PURPOSE: Oversees all faculty matters except policies pertaining to academic freedom and tenure. Specific responsibilities are outlined in the Academic Senate Constitution.

MEETINGS: Regular meetings shall be held at least once in each of the first and second terms, but historically, have not been held monthly. Special meetings can be held in response to actions outlined in the Senate Constitution.

MEMBERSHIP COMPOSITION: Thirty-nine members, with composition as outlined in the Senate Constitution. In summary, there are twenty-four faculty members representing all academic divisions, six deans, Senior VP for Educational Affairs and Provost, and eight student representatives. All are voting members, except Provost only votes to break ties.
